

1. GLOBE in the UK

- Over 500 GLOBE Schools registered
- Over 1,000 GLOBE Teachers trained
- Most not reporting data... but some very good schools


GLOBE-UK Funding 1995 - 2007

2. The Northumbrian Water GLOBE Project

- Water Companies in the UK are privatised utilities
- Different companies have different water catchments
- They are responsible for supply of drinking water and disposal of sewage
- Many English water companies now owned by the French

2. The Northumbrian Water GLOBE Project

- Northumbrian Water need more rainfall sampling points
- Motivation is climate change – need for more accuracy
- They recognised GLOBE as a way of engaging schools
- They will give each school an Automated Weather Station
- They will support each school to be a GLOBE School
- In return, they want the data sent directly to them

2. The Northumbrian Water GLOBE Project

- They will support 60 schools to become GLOBE Schools
- May increase up to 80 schools!
- Secondary and primary – they will select the schools
- We will provide training and support to motivate the new Northumbrian Water GLOBE Network
- Northumbrian Water was owned 100% by Suez Lyonnaise des Eaux – now 25 % Suez, 75% ‘Aquavit’ - a consortium comprising Deutsche Bank, Collins Stewart and Ecofin.
