- ✚ One teacher workshop in Carto, Costa Rica, in partnership with Omar Dengo Foundation, GLOBE's Country Coordinators for Costa Rica.
- ✚ Collaboration between Costa Rica students and WV students through the Integrated Design for Geoscience Education, Marshall University.
- ✚ Collaboration between OH View, WV View, MD View, and PA View leading to NASA IPY GLOBE/SATELLITES Program workshops in OH year 1, OH and WV year 2, adding PA and MD in year 3.

Partnership Summary:

- Began training teachers in May 2003.
- Conducted 76 teacher training workshops and 4 Train-the-Trainer workshops.
- GLOBE in West Virginia has partnered with over 6 institutions of higher education and over 12 county school districts to receive over a million dollars in state and federal funding to conduct annual summer institutes since 2003—averaging over 100 newly certified educators each year.
