



TALKING TO YOUR ELDERS ABOUT TREES AND LAND COVER

STEPS FOR VIDEO:

1. CHOOSE AN ADULT TO INTERVIEW. ONE THAT HAS SEEN CHANGES IN TREES AND LAND COVER OVER THE LAST 10-50 YEARS, IN YOUR LOCATION
 - a. IN THE VIDEO, IDENTIFY:
 - i. YOUR NAME
 - ii. INTERVIEWEE NAME
 - iii. LOCATION – GLOBE COUNTRY
2. INTERVIEW AND RECORD THEM IN A SETTING WITH TREES AND/OR AN AREA WITH INTERESTING LANDCOVER.
3. FOCUS ON THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS:
 - a. WHAT CHANGES IN TREES HAVE YOU SEEN IN THIS AREA OVER THE LAST 10, 20, 50 YEARS?
 - b. WHAT CHANGES IN LANDCOVER AND LANDSCAPE HAVE YOU SEEN IN THIS AREA OVER THE LAST 10, 20, 50 YEARS?
4. FINISH THE VIDEO BY HIGHLIGHTING THE FOLLOWING?
 - a. WHERE ARE THE TREES IN MY AREA?
 - b. HOW TALL ARE THE TREES IN MY AREA?
 - c. ARE THE TREES IN MY AREA GETTING TALLER AND DENSER OR IS THE TREE POPULATION DECREASING?

THE VIDEOS SHOULD BE BETWEEN 3-5 MINUTES IN LENGTH. WE WILL SHOW THESE VIDEOS DURING OUR APRIL AND MAY 2023 CAMPAIGN WEBINARS!
