## Instructions:

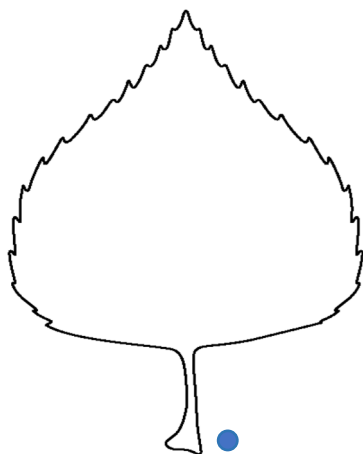
1. Go outside and check your adopted 4 leaves.

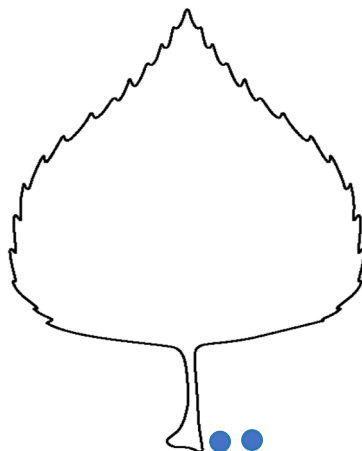

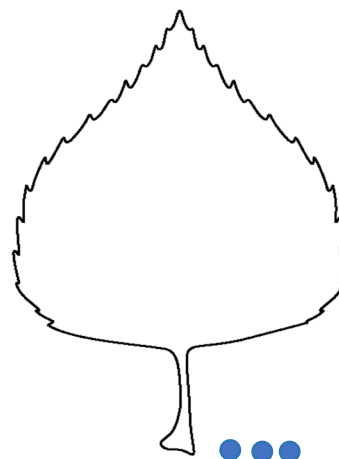

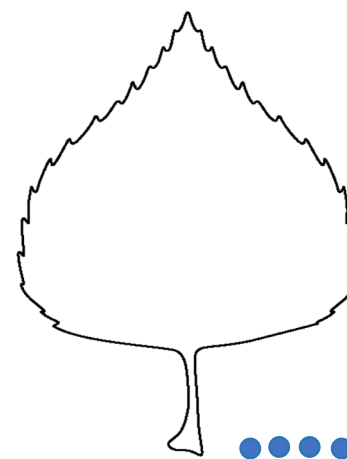
