Stratus clouds look like a sheet or blanket. Cumulus clouds look like cotton or cauliflower. Stratocumulus clouds look like a lumpy blanket.











LOW Under 2000m




Nimbostratus clouds produce light rain or a steady drizzle, while cumulonimbus clouds produce intense storms.
