

## **Site description:**

- Located at the foot of a hill.
- Predominantly Grassland with some shrubs and small trees. There was almost no bare ground visible due to the numerous grasses.
- Indigenous species: Highveld grasses (average height of 1.5m), acacia species, small aloes (knee height) and field lilies.
- Invasive species: Pom poms.
- Vegetation: Winter season non-growing season.
- Land use: vacant land with a possibility for development in the future. Habitat for some indigenous species such as barn owls, small rodents and reptiles such as snakes, toads and small lizards.
- Topography: level ground with a patchwork of terrestrial burrows and termite mounds. There is also a road running adjacent to the one side of the 30 x 30 study area.
- Composition: 90% grasses and 10% shrubs.
