Covered Travel Expenses for the Winners of the U.S. Schools Competition

1. Round Trip Flight (Economy Class Ticket)
2. *Travel Assistant and ID Theft Protection Services from The Hartford*

3. Hotel costs (Arrival on August 3, 2014 – Departure on August 9, 2014 – 2 rooms Max (Male/Female) any accommodation requirements outside of these dates will be at your own expense.
4. Meeting Registration Fee which includes the below:
 - Transportation to and from GLE venue from International Airport
 - Field visits, excursions, banquets, cultural program
 - Participation in GLE, display of exhibits
 - Breakfast, lunch, dinner and refreshments beginning with Dinner on Sunday, August 3 and ending with Dinner on Friday, August 8
 - Registration material, conference bag, pen, pad and GLOBE memento

Uncovered Travel Expenses (that you may incur)

1. Passport and Visa Costs*
2. Transportation from your home to your home airport
3. Parking at your home airport
4. Baggage Fees. Most carriers allow one checked bag for international flights (62" total Length X Width X Height and under 50 pounds). Please visit your carrier's website for specific allowable baggage and requirements.
5. Meals in transit

*GLE participants are requested to contact the Indian Consulate in their country of citizenship regarding Visa requirements. Specifics about visa applications in your country should be available through an internet search. A good site to begin with is [Bureau of Immigration](#). A personalized letter of invitation will be provided to you. If you do not have your passport already please get this as soon as possible if you plan on attending the GLE. Visas for India could take up to 2 months to obtain, if not longer.
