Out of 233 GLOBE Schools, only a few schools have required facilities for data collection. Our plan is to make all schools in Tanzania active and provide required material which will enable them to collect data and enter them in the Globe system for the intended purpose.

Training, seminars and workshops will be scheduled for teachers, students and researchers to enhance their knowledge and thirst to participate in the Globe Program efficiently.

We will reach out to more partners, researchers, universities, and other stake holders in order to increase participation in the Globe Program. We will encourage collaboration among Globe School members in the country and outside the country for them to learn from each other.

With all this, we will need support from GIO for us to reach our goals. We will try to learn from other Partner countries and share experiences on similar challenges.

To add value and efficiency in our programs we have added a Country Coordinator for schools/colleges and partners.

Before the end of the year 2024 our plan is to register about 1000 schools and make them active in Globe observations and data entry.
