- In 2019 community clean-ups collected 3.4tons of waste, which excludes daily litter runs by the team on the river.
- Committed and willing to increase awareness on environmental topics in the community.



Presentation

Bird Counting is a census of birds performed annually by volunteer birdwatchers.

Purpose = to provide population data for use in science, especially conservation biology, by determining findings about our natural habitats and the birds that use them.

If repeated at regular intervals, the counts allow us to track changes in bird population.

Twice a year, in midsummer (the last Saturday in January) and midwinter (the last Saturday in July), road counts are carried out using this standardised method. A standardised method allows one to make comparisons between counts.

Routes have been grouped into clusters called precincts. Local Precinct Organisers play a vital role in organising counts in their areas. Currently there are 42 precincts in eight provinces.

CURRENT IDEA OF ENVISAGED PROTOCOL OF WHAT, HOW AND WHEN WE WILL MEASURE RIVER HEALTH INDICATORS-

1. USE THE I WATER LAB KIT http://www.ilabwater.co.za

The iLab- established in 2019 -main objective of creating affordable and easy to use tools for the testing of water quality.

The iLab water test kit is designed for non-scientific field operatives to do a basic screening of the water quality and to solve the problem of contaminated water.







EPA verified tests. Login DATA Dashboard available.

The iLab water test kit - indicate ewage, industrial or agricultural contamination. Determine presence or absence of chemicals and bacteria that can be harmful for human and animal consumption. Helps the user make an informed decision on the way forward.

Bacterial components

The kit includes the following two tests for microbial bacteria in water: E. coli / Coliform Count Plate & Faecal Coliform test

Chemical contaminants

The chemical test strip (testing levels of pH, Nitrate, Nitrite, Lead, Copper, Iron, Fluoride and Chlorine). Test can also give an indication of the alkalinity and hardness of the water. It also includes Phosphate test.

Secondly: Anyone can learn how to collect a miniSASS sample on a river. Once you have collected a sample you look for the different bug groups and score whether they were found. The score then tells you the health class of the river, ranging across five categories from natural to very poor.

Get your community, school or family and friends involved in monitoring a selection of your streams and rivers. In this way a map of river health across Southern Africa will develop. Communities can use the information and knowledge to illustrate the plight of their rivers, connect with other miniSASS samplers and investigate pollution sources.

NOTE: miniSASS does NOT measure the contamination of the water by bacteria and viruses and thus does not tell us if the river water is fit to drink. The current version works online and therefore users should be connected while using the app.





CHALLENGES:

- ♣ CHALLENGE IS STILL WHERE TO KEEP THE DATABASE AND WHO WILL MAN THIS AND WHO WILL DO SOMETHING WITH THIS INFORMATION?
- HOW TO GET EXISTING GROUPS ALREADY GATHERING INFORMATION ON -BOARD TO USE THE STANDARDISED PROTOCOL (STILL TO BE DEVELOPED)- HUGE MARKETING AND AWARENESS CAMPAIGN NECESSARY......START SMALL AND EAT THE ELEPHANT BITE BY BITE
- REMOTE AREAS MIGHT HAVE CHALLENGES- DATA CONNECTION, HOW TO GET TEST KITS TO THEM ETC..STANDARDISED PROTOCOL MUST MAKE PROVISION FOR THIS.





IN CONCLUSION:

THIS GROUND -TRUTHING/VERIFICATION DATA COLLECTION FOR RIVER QUALITY AND HEALTH INFORMATION CAN BE SUPPLEMENTARY AND VERY WORTHWHILE IN MANAGING AND PROTECTING OUR VALUABLE WATER RESOURCES AND GET OUR COMMUNITIES AND SCHOOLS BACK TO NATURE- TAKING OWNERSHIP OF THEIR ENVIRONMENT!
