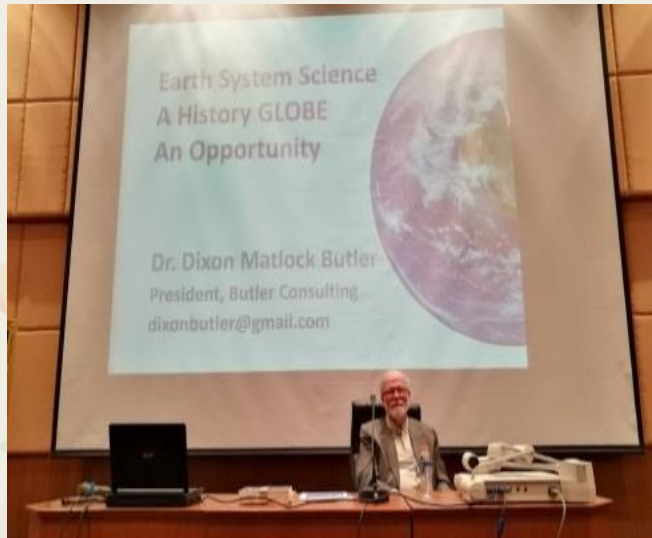
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Promotion of Environmental Science Research in Thailand

- 24 oral presentations and 40 poster presentations.



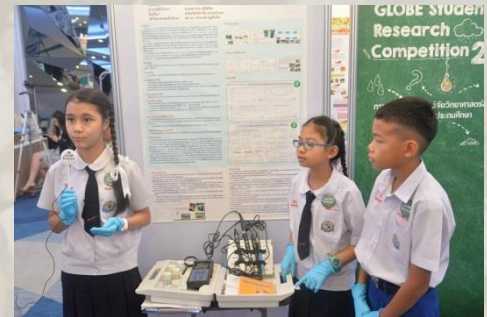

4.2 Thailand Junior Water Prize 2017 (TJWP2017)

- To encourage students to learn about, care for, and conserve water resources.
- The winner was “A Remote Water Quality Monitoring System in Bang Pood Canal and Chao Phraya River, Nonthaburi Province” from Suankularb Wittayalai Nonthaburi School, Nonthaburi province.
- Presented their research at Stockholm Junior Water Prize 2017, Sweden on 26 – 30 August, 2017.

- The winner was “The Synthesis and Characterization of Sensors Based on Magnetic Nanoparticles for Heavy Metal Detection” from Kamnoetvidya Science Academy, Rayong Province.

5.4 Sunburst Environment Programme 2017

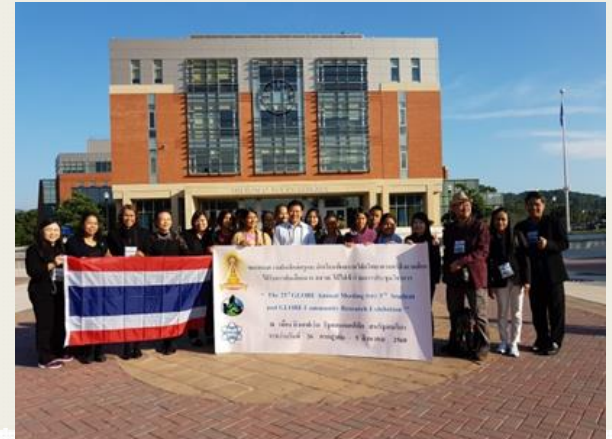
- 12 – 18 November 2017 at RELC International Hotel, Singapore.

- Maximum 30 participants (India 10, Taiwan 10 and the other 10)

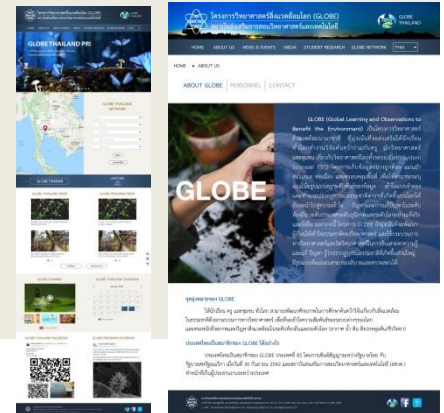
