As a part of Zika Education and Prevention Project under the GLOBE Program, ECCA has been conducting series of Country Mosquito Trainings since June, 2018. In this regard, local mosquito training program was conducted on May 17 and June 14, 2019 at Crescent Academy, Godawari and Little Flower Public School, Sankhamul respectively. Altogether 51



A reflection session on GLOBE protocols i.e. Atmospheric Investigation (temperature, rainfall, and humidity measurement and cloud cover estimation) and Hydrological Investigation (water PH, temperature and electrical conductivity) were conducted. Questioning-Answering and interaction were done to clarify the participants' quires.

Similary, the third CMT is planned for Jhapa which will be conducted on November 21, 2019 for 5 schools. There will be 25 students and teachers and one representative of health offices in the areas.

ECCA is doing awareness on management of mosquito disease and the Zika Zine book will help it more where internet is not easily accessible or for them also.



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The comic will make ease to create interest among students and teachers to aware on management of mosquitos. It has been distributed in different ECCA working schools.

School Garden and Open Space Management Program

ECCA is conducting Green School Project starting from February 2019. The project covers Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) and Agro-Ecology. The project aims to improve the environment in the school through the construction of gardens in the open space available in the school, which involves the students, supported by a plant nursery. The program is initiated in altogether 12 schools in Lalitpur, Jhapa and Dolakha.
