In the process of work of our ecological circle "Researcher", we dealt with ecological problems of small rivers of Poltava region.



The object of our observation was the river Yamka, which is a tributary of the river Vorskla.



We conducted environmental work, leaflets, and booklets calling to protect nature and in particular rivers and springs among the local population.



Having analyzed the current ecological condition of the reservoir, we can observe negative processes on the Yamka River:



the water level has dropped significantly in both Vorskla and Yamka.



Most of the river is clogged and therefore has lost its natural significance.



Of great importance for the protection of small rivers is the fight against water erosion and siltation, protection of river sources, the creation of water protection zones.



The inclusion of catchment areas in the nature reserve fund and in the ecological network is important for the conservation of biodiversity and ecosystems of small rivers.
