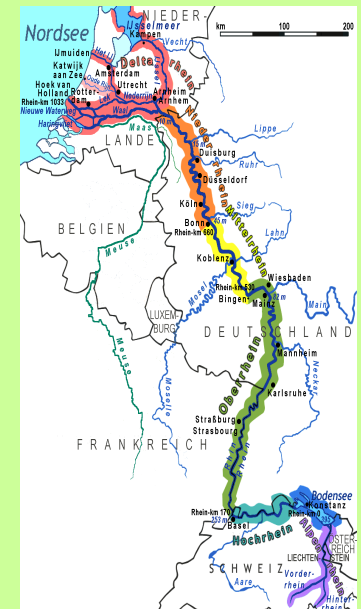
Leading questions for the Project „Tributary Rivers“
