





Italy - and used the micro plastic protocol



I am for the sea

We created a community and together we prepared the program that took place in IO schools in Israel, and one school in Malta:

- I. The students were collecting data by the protocols of the Globe program
- 2. The students collected microplastics data
- 3. The students went on learning days at the beach
- 4. The students conducted a survey of knowledge, awareness and behavior among the communities of the participating schools parents, teachers and students
- 5. The students wrote research papers
- 6. The students met scientists from the academy
- 7. The students prepared video clips in order to raise awareness for preserving the marine environment
- 8. The students met activists from sea conservation associations and learned about activism
