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Organization and Number of Staff:

All three employees work for the Ministry of Education in cooperation with the GLOBE Regional Office

Funding by:

We obtained a grant from the US Embassy to train five new schools in Aqaba, including ten teachers and fifty students, and provide them with the necessary equipment.

The regional office works with the Ministry of Education in Jordan

GLOBE Schools:

Two schools are currently participating in the GLOBE program, and in December five new schools will join from Aqaba

GLOBE Protocol Areas:

During this year, we worked to focus on the atmospheric cover. GLOBE students were intensively trained on this cover by a Globe teacher who supervised them during their application. Students will be trained on new protocols to apply throughout the year

Program Implementation, International Cooperation in GLOBE Network, and Activities over Past Year (categorized by GLOBE Strategic Plan 2018-2023 Goals):

● Education

The GLOBE team and the regional office were keen to provide the largest possible number of workshops and training courses for teachers and students who are already participating in the program and for the new participants to get to know the GLOBE program well, and ensure their effective participation in it.

A grant was obtained from the US Embassy to finance the Globe program in 5 new schools in Aqaba and to provide them with tools and training over a period of 10 months, starting in December.

And teacher from King Abdullah II School for Excellence in Zarqa participated and won the learning activities competition with the support of the GLOBE Regional Office in Jordan.

● Science

GLOBE students carried out many scientific researches and participated in several occasions and scientific competitions. Six students from the King Abdullah II School for Excellence in Zarqa started four scientific researches over two years. They participated in the virtual international exhibition IVSS twice. They got a high evaluation and several badges. They also

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participated in the Earth Day celebration on 4/21/2022, which was held in Al Chouf school in cooperation with the regional office, the Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Agriculture.

- Community

GLOBE students and teachers cooperate with each other, as regular meetings are held between the GLOBE team at Tamayoz Zarqa School and the Shouf School team to exchange information, experiences and cooperate in conducting research. Cooperation between the two teams was in several activities such as Earth Day and the regional meeting in Jordan.

- Technology

Students depend a lot on technology in their research, such as: smart devices and digital devices to collect and analyze data. They also use modern technology to enter data on a daily basis using special websites and applications besides the using of I pads.

- Communications

The regional office communicates with GLOBE coordinators and teachers on a regular basis to ensure that the necessary technical support is provided for the team to work in the best way.

Plans and Ideas for Next Year:

During the next year, about five new schools , ten teacher and 50 students will be trained in Aqaba and provided with the necessary equipment. We hope to add more schools and students during the next year. We also expect the number of data entered into the system to increase significantly as a result of the increased interaction of students with the protocols they have been trained on.
