
Plant Growth Observations

- 3) Measure the root.
- 4) Measure the seed.
- 5) Measure the stem.
- 6) Compare and contrast root and stem.
- 7) Label the plant at each stage of growth.
- 8) Count the roots, leaves, etc.
- 9) In class observation of real life growth. Observe and write what's happening over time.
- 10) Name what a plant needs to survive.
- 11) Act out what happens to a seed as it's growing.
- 12) Research a favorite plant.
