

- is mostly found as a tree, but sometimes also as a high shrub, up to 10 m high, but with maximum height of about 8 m.
- The leaves are deciduous, lobed (three to five lobes), 10-25 cm long and/or wide, coarse on the upper side, somewhat hairy on the lower side.
- Fruit is pear-like, green or dark red and glabrous on the outside. Fleshy interior of the fruit is also filled with many seeds (nuts).
- ❖ The bark is ash grey, light in color and smooth.

Distribution

Fig generally grows on semi open areas, and is widespread in cultivated areas with the center of its distribution in the Mediterranean.
