

Upward Bound STEM Day with NASA/AREN July 11, 2019 – University of Maryland Eastern Shore

On July 11th, the University of Maryland Eastern Shore hosted thirty (30) <u>Upward Bound</u> Students and seven (7) teachers supported by college mentors to partake in the first STEM Day event with NASA/AREN. Previously, there was a teacher workshop on May 25th for training purposes in efforts to aid in the organizing of the STEM Day Event. The students were involved in a workshop introduction (1.5 hours), design challenge (1.5 hours) and kite flying (1 hour). The event took place from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm. It was amazing to witness 30 students engaged, all who were flying kites at one time.
