


Funny Learning with Clouds (Activities Guide)

A Spoon Can Tell what are Clouds Made of?

What do you need?

1 metal spoon per kid.

- 1. Pass the spoons to the kids and let them notice that spoons are cool.
- 2. Ask the kids to hold the back of the spoons close to their mouths and exhale.
- 3. Ask the kids to explain tiny cloud forming on the back of the spoons.





Let's Make Clouds and Rain

What do you need?

- Glass jar.
- Metal plate.
- Hot water.
- Ice cubes.
- Flashlight.

- 1. Fill the jar up to third with hot water.
- 2. Place the ice cubes in the metal plate.
- 3. Put the metal plate over the top of the jar.
- 4. Ask the kids to watch and explain what happens!





Funny Water Cycle

What do you need?

- A3 white paper.
- Pencil.
- Ruler.
- Color pencils.
- Colored papers.
- Cotton.
- Glue.
- Scissors (Use safety kinds for kids).

- 1. Discuss the water cycle with the kids.
- 2. Ask the kids to draw water cycle as funny story using materials above.





Cloud Cover Simulation

What do you need?

- White papers.
- Pencil.
- Ruler.
- Flannel cloth.
- Cardboard.
- Fixing strip.
- Glue or stapler.
- Scissors.

- 1. Cover the cardboard with flannel cloth and fix it using glue or stapler.
- 2. Cut the white papers to make small clouds then paste the fixing strip with them.
- 3. Ask the kids to simulate every kind of cloud cover by fixing the small clouds on the flannel board.





Clouds Puzzle

What do you need?

- Clouds pictures (Different types).
- Pencil.
- Ruler.
- Scalpel.
- Cardboard.
- Glue.
- Scissors.

- 1. Paste the pictures on the cardboard.
- 2. Cut the pictures in any puzzle shape.
- 3. Ask the kids to install the puzzle.
- 4. Ask the kids to specify and describe the type of the clouds.





Clouds Cards

What do you need?

- Clouds pictures (Different types) printed on thick paper and snipped as cards.
- Clouds names printed on thick paper and snipped as cards.
- Clouds identifications printed on thick paper and snipped as cards.

- 1. Put every type of cards as a group.
- 2. Ask the kids to match the cloud picture with its name and identification.





Clouds Story or Booklet

What do you need?

- A4 white papers.
- Pencil.
- Ruler.
- Color pencils.
- Colored papers.
- Cotton.
- Glue.
- Scissors (Use safety kinds for kids).

- 1. Ask the kids to pleat the A4 paper from the middle to form booklet.
- 2. Ask the kids to create a story about cloud formation and types using materials above.
- 3. Ask the kids to read the stories to their friends.





Clouds Theater

What do you need?

- White papers.
- Pencil.
- Color pencils.
- Colored papers.
- Glue.
- Scissors (Use safety kinds for kids).

- 1. Ask the kids to cut the white paper to form different shapes of clouds.
- 2. Ask the kids to create funny characters for these clouds using materials above.
- 3. Ask the kids to create show about cloud types using these characters.





Make Your Own Cloud Chart

What do you need?

- Clouds pictures (Different types).
- A3 White papers.
- Pencil.
- Ruler.
- Glue.
- Scissors (Use safety kinds for kids).
