GLOBE PILOT VIRTUAL EXCHANGE PROGRAM

The GLOBE Program seeks teachers to test the new **GLOBE Virtual Exchange Toolkit** as part of a pilot Virtual Exchange Program.

GLOBE VIRTUAL EXCHANGE TOOLKIT

Developed in partnership with the U.S. Department of State Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs, the **GLOBE Virtual Exchange Toolkit** provides step-by-step guidelines for teachers on how to organize and co-host a virtual exchange program with another teacher.

Testing the GLOBE Virtual Exchange Toolkit

Using the Toolkit as a guide, teachers will independently host virtual exchange sessions with another teacher. Following the pilot program, participants will provide feedback and recommendations to GLOBE staff on the Toolkit, prior to GLOBE launching the Toolkit to the full GLOBE community.

Pilot Program Participation Prerequisites

- Trained as a GLOBE Teacher, and currently using GLOBE protocols in student research or measurements.
- High-speed internet connection.
- Approximately six hours to plan and conduct the virtual exchange sessions.
